SUPPORT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

17TH TRAINING WING

I. Purpose: To define the support to be provided by the Commander, 17th Training Wing, Goodfellow AFB, TX to the Marine Corps Detachment, located at Goodfellow AFB, TX.

II. Authority:

- a. DODI 4000.19, Interservice, Interdepartmental and Interagency Support
- b. AFR 50-18, Interservice Education and Training

III. Definitions:

- a. Supplier: The organization element which has management control of the operational facilities. For the purpose of this agreement, the 17th Training Wing, Goodfellow AFB, Texas, will hereinafter be referred to as the Supplier.
- b. Receiver: The organizational element which uses the operational facilities. For the purpose of this agreement, the Marine Corps Detachment, Goodfellow AFB, Texas, will hereafter be referred to as the Receiver.
- c. Executive Agent: The organization charged with responsibility for the conduct of a joint or consolidated training program is the Executive Agent. Included in the Executive Agent concept is all related logistics and training support except full instructor complement, unique equipment, and unit administrative staffs required for students belonging to the other services. For the purpose of this agreement, the 17th Training Wing, Goodfellow AFB, Texas, is the Executive Agent for the technical training provided to the Marine Corps Detachment student personnel.

IV. Funding:

At this time, OSD has NOT approved "fee for services" for the reimbursement of Base Operating Support (BOS). Additionally, Congressional law states that BOS is "not approved" to be put under DBOF. Reimbursement will be accomplished by Standard Form (SF) 1080. Each SF 1080 will contain the statement that costs for services are IAW AFM 172-1, Vol. I and AFR 172-5. The SF 1080 will be forwarded to the Receiver for verification and certification prior to forwarding to the Receiver's major command. These funding arrangements and policies will be put in effect at such time as the Defense Business Operating Fund (DBOF) is initiated by the Department of Defense. At that time, the Marine Corps Detachment at Goodfellow will receive funding from the Air Force to reimburse the Supplier of said services for those specific services requested and received.

ADMIN Administrative Services

Includes records management, personnel locator, document control and handling, forms and publications, and maintenance of official publications reference libraries.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include records management, personnel locator, document control and handling, forms and publications, copying services, Armed Forces Courier Service (AFCS) support, and maintenance of official publications reference libraries.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

ADP Automated Data Processing and Automation Services

Includes data processing services and systems analysis. Also, includes design, development, execution, and life cycle maintenance of data processing systems.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include data processing, systems analysis, design, development, execution, and life cycle maintenance.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

AUDIO VISUAL Audio and Visual Information Services

Includes still photography, graphics, micro graphics, and presentation services. Also, includes film, video and audio media services.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include still photography, graphics, presentation services, films, microfilms, micrographic services, video tapes, and other visual media information services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

CHAPEL Chapel and Chaplain Services

Includes pastoral ministries, worship services, religious rites, pastoral visits, spiritual counseling, and religious education.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include pastoral visits, worship services, religious rites, spiritual counseling and religious education.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Request services as needed.

CLUBS Clubs

Includes officer, non-commissioned officer, enlisted, all hands, aery, community and other recreational clubs.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include officer, enlisted all hands, community and other recreation clubs. Also includes bowling centers, campgrounds, marinas, and related services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and directives.

COMM Communication Services

Includes dedicated communications services and telephone equipment. May also include leasing of communication equipment, lines, and special communications-electronics equipment services.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include base communications facilities, telephone equipment and services. May also include the leasing of communication equipment, lines, and special communications-electronics equipment services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

COMMAND SPT Command Support

Includes oversight and management provided by the installation commander and the command element office staff.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include command activities necessary to the accomplishment of mandatory reimbursable support.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

COMMON INFRA Common Use Facility Construction, Operations, Maintenance, and Repair

Includes construction, alteration, operation, maintenance, and repair of common use infrastructure (e.g., roads, grounds, surfaced areas, structures, real property and installed equipment). Also includes common benefit signs, energy consumption, snow removal, street cleaning, and installation beautification projects.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include maintenance, repair and minor construction or alterations of common use infrastructure, roads, grounds, surface areas, structures, real property and installed equipment. Also includes common benefit signs, energy consumption and beautification projects.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

COMMUN SVCS Community Services

Includes family support center activities, child development services, dependent youth activities, theaters, and thrift shops.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include child development and care programs, youth services, family support center activities, hobby shops, and craft centers.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

DISASTER Disaster Preparedness

Includes operation of disaster preparedness programs and related services, equipment and facility support for emergencies and wartime operations.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include the operation of Disaster programs and regulations, related services, equipment, and facility support for emergencies and wartime operations.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

EDUCATION Education Services

Includes instruction, counseling, and testing.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include instruction, counseling, and testing.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

ENTOMOLOGY Entomology Services

Includes abatement and control measures directed against insects, rodents, weeds, fungi, and other animals or plants that are determined to be undesirable in buildings, equipment, supplies, and on grounds.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide entomology and pest control for facilities.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Request services as needed.

ENVIR CLEAN Environmental Cleanup

Includes collection, clean-up, transportation, and disposal of hazardous material.

Supplier Will:

Receiver Will:

1 Provide for the administration of programs for the disposal of hazardous materials and other forms of pollution.

1 Comply with local, State and Federal policies and regulations.

ENVIR COMPLY Environmental Compliance

Includes recycling and resource recovery programs, pollution prevention, environmental compliance, and programs aimed at management and control of hazardous materials -- does not include clean-up and disposal of hazardous materials.

Supplier Will:

1 Provide programs which include the administration of programs for the control of hazardous materials and other forms of pollution. Also includes recycling and resource recovery programs.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local, State and Federal policies and regulations.

EQUIP MAINT Equipment Maintenance, Repair, and Calibration

Includes maintenance, repair, and calibration of industrial equipment, construction equipment, laboratory equipment, office equipment, and other non-tactical equipment -- does not include vehicles.

Supplier Will:

1 Provide services which include the maintenance and repair of USMC industrial equipment, electronic equipment, and office equipment.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

FACIL CONSTR Facility Construction and Major Repair

Includes minor construction, alterations, additions, and major repairs required to modernize, replace, expand or restore real property. Also, includes related planning and design.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include the provision of facilities and real property. Also includes construction of new facilities and structures, addition to existing facilities, and alterations that change the use of existing facilities.
- 2 Provide services which include planning, design and programming functions necessary to the construction, fabrication, and repair of facilities and equipment.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

FACIL REPAIR Facility Maintenance and Minor Repair

Includes routine and cyclical preventive maintenance and minor repairs required to preserve or restore real property so it may be used for its designated purpose.

Supplier Will:

Receiver Will:

- 1 Provide services which include maintenance and repair of real property, installed equipment, miscellaneous structures, roads, grounds, railroads, and surfaced areas when scope exceeds Receivers capabilities.

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

FINANCE Finance and Accounting

Includes expense, reimbursement, working fund, payroll and leave accounting provided by Defense Finance & Accounting Service. Also includes disbursing, voucher and in-invoice examination, financial reporting, and the development of accounting systems.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services for emergency or transient payments on a nonreimbursable basis. Transient payments will only be made to Marine Corps members in transient between duty stations or on TDY. Regular military pay and allowances will be processed by U.S. Marine Corps Finance Center, Kansas City, MO, for Marine Corps personnel. Supplier will also provide monthly per diem payments to Marine authorized per diem entitlement.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

FIRE Fire Protection

Includes all normal services related to fire protection and fighting operations, alert service, and rescue operations. Also, includes inspections for fire hazards, servicing of portable extinguishers, and related training programs.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include fire protection and prevention programs.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Request services as needed.

FOOD Food Service

Includes preparation and service of food to authorized personnel, and related dining facilities operations.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include provisioning, preparation and serving of food to authorized personnel, and the operation of dining facilities.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.
-

HEALTH Health Services

Includes administration of health care program, inpatient and outpatient medical and dental treatment, and other related medical support and professional services. Also, includes veterinary support.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include outpatient testing, treatment, rehabilitation, and associated professional services, medical support; may also include inpatient services. Includes environmental health inspections and quality assurance services, and veterinarian services for military working dogs only.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

HSG & LODGE Housing and Lodging Services

Includes family, unmarried, and unaccompanied housing referral services. Also, includes operation of family housing, bachelor officer quarters, bachelor enlisted quarters, and transient accommodations.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include accommodations and housing referral services for authorized personnel. Also includes the provision of transient accommodations.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

LEGAL Legal Services

Includes the provision of advice and services on all legal matters pertaining to legal assistance, military justice, initial claims processing, property utilization, award and execution of procurement contracts, and personnel matters such as conflicts of interest, standards of conduct, and grievance hearings/reviews.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide Area Defense Council for services and referral administrative support only.
- 2 Provide legal services which include the provision of advice and services on all legal matters pertaining to legal assistance, initial claims processing, property utilization award and execution of contracts and personal matters, such as conflicts of interest and standards of conduct.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

MAGISTRATE NON-STANDARD

Includes authority to authorize searches of persons, places, and things to seize evidence of criminal activity.

Supplier Will:

Receiver Will:

- 1 Notify the Receiver within a reasonable amount of time period of any search.
- 2 Provide a neutral magistrate to review for probable cause determination and order such searches/seizures as necessary.

- 1 Continue to retain through the Receiver's command the authority to order such searches/seizures as necessary over its own military personnel and those areas controlled by the Receiver. This authority is concurrent in jurisdiction with the magistrate supplied by the Supplier.
- 2 Comply with all search orders by the designated magistrate.

MAIL POSTAGE Mail Service

Includes collecting/accepting, sorting, routing, and delivery of official and personal mail on DoD installations and in DoD owned or leased facilities.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which includes mail sorting, routing, and delivery services not provided by the United States Postal Service.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations. Provide own indicia material with appropriate DOD indemnification for all official mail.

MIL PERS Military Personnel Support

Includes passport, forces stamp, social security, and other personal affairs services for military personnel. Also includes processing of identification cards, security clearances, testing of individuals, line of duty investigation reports, casualty assistance reporting, noncombatant evacuation operations, relocation assistance, and transition assistance.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include passports and other personal affairs services for military personnel. Also includes processing of identification cards, testing of individuals, line-of-duty investigation reports, casualty assistance reporting, non-combatant evacuation operations, relocation assistance and transition assistance.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Provide a Chief Warrant Officer, MOS 7002, to serve as Deputy Joint Fire Protection Training Officer. Due to the time required to complete instructor proficiency training and subject matter qualifications requirements, inbound USMC replacement personnel must arrive a minimum of 3 months prior to the departure of an incumbent instructor. This will ensure sufficient time to train the new arrival in both the classroom environment and receive necessary instructor qualification training. Comply with local policies and regulations.

MORTUARY Mortuary Services

Includes all logistical functions related to the recovery, identification, care, and disposition of deceased personnel. Includes CONUS port, and overseas mortuary services.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide service which include CONUS, port, and overseas mortuary services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

MWR Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Activities

Includes operation of recreational centers, gyms, fitness centers, parks, athletic fields, recreational and general reference libraries, hobby shops, craft centers, and related services.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include recreation and general library services.
- 2 Provide programs which include recreation centers, athletic fields and related services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

POLICE Police Services

Includes maintaining law and order (e.g., enforcement of traffic laws, accident investigation, and criminal investigations), traffic management, vehicle decals, and parking pass services. Also, includes operation of confinement and detention facilities, and related services.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide programs which include the provision of personnel confinement and detention services.
- 2 Provide programs which include guards, security protection, maintenance of law and order, and crime prevention measures.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

PUBL AFFAIRS Public Affairs

Includes activities aimed toward responding directly or through news media to the general public's right and need to know how DoD activities accomplish assigned tasks and missions. Also includes distribution of public and community relations information.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide installation wide Public Affairs services.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

PURCH/CONTR Purchasing and Contracting Services

Includes acquisition and contract administration services for procurement of property, equipment, services, construction, and supplies. Also includes services for renting and leasing.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include acquisition and contract administration services for procurement of property, equipment, services and supplies. Also includes services for renting and leasing equipment, facilities, and real property.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

REFUSE Refuse Collection and Disposal

Includes collection and disposal of trash and waste materials.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include collection and disposal of trash and waste materials. Also includes operation of incinerators and other facilities and equipment intended for the transportation, disposal or destruction of waste materials.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

RESOURC MGNT Resource Management

Includes funds management, cost analysis services, and budget formulation, reporting, and execution. Also includes financial liability investigation of property losses.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which includes funds management, cost analysis services, and formulation, reporting and execution of operating budget. Also includes Reports of Survey actions.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and directives.

SOCIAL ACTNS Social Actions

Includes civilian and military personnel assistance and training pertaining to substance abuse and human relations.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide Social Actions counseling services when requested.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and directives.

STORAGE Storage and Warehousing

Includes provision of space and services related to the management of commodities, material, and equipment; includes receipt, storage, issue, and shipment of items from storage.

Supplier Will:

- 1 Provide services which include the storage and distribution of commodities, materials, equipment and fuels. Also includes all operations from receipt of materiel and equipment into storage to issue and shipment of items from storage.

Receiver Will:

- 1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

TECH LIBRARY Technical and Legal Libraries

Includes technical and legal libraries, and services that provide limited reference information for official purposes.

Supplier Will:

Receiver Will:

1 Provide services which include technical and legal libraries and services that provide limited reference information for specific purposes.

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

TRAINING Training Service

Includes instruction and use of target ranges, simulators, and other training facilities.

Supplier Will:

1 Provide services which include instruction and use of small arms range, simulators and other training facilities.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

TRANSPORT Transportation Services

Includes transportation services related to both commercial and government-owned transportation of personnel, personal property, and material. Also includes shipment planning, packing and crating, port clearance, scheduling, processing of transportation documents, and related transportation services.

Supplier Will:

1 Provide services which include travel office services, and other transportation services related to both commercial and government owned transportation of personnel and material. Also includes shipment planning, packing and crating, port clearance, scheduling, processing of transportation documents, and provision of related transportation services for both personnel and personal property.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

UTILITIES Utilities

Includes water, sewage, electricity, natural gas, and fuel oil services. Also, includes central generation and distribution of steam, chilled water, and compressed air.

Supplier Will:

1 Provide services which include the provision for procurement, production and distribution of utilities, heating and air conditioning. Also includes energy consumption and conservation programs.

Receiver Will:

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

VEHICLE SPT Vehicle Support

Includes maintenance and repair of customer vehicles, and supply, maintenance and repair of vehicles provided for a customer's use. Also, includes chartered transportation services.

Supplier Will:

Receiver Will:

1 Provide all scheduled and unscheduled maintenance for USMC fire protection vehicles. Goodfellow AFB will not fund maintenance replacement parts associated with USMC fire protection vehicles until such time as the financial plan can provide programming for that funding.

2 Provide services which include motor pool operations, maintenance and repair of vehicles. Also includes maintenance and repair of USMC fire protection training vehicles.

1 Comply with local policies and regulations.

2 Any additional training vehicles, or changes in types of vehicles, will be provided by the U.S. Marine Corps. Any training vehicles requiring replacement due to unserviceability or obsolescence must be forecasted for and replaced by the U.S. Marine Corps.
