Subj: OFFICER MISCONDUCT REPORTING PROCEDURES

Ref: (a) MCO P5800.16A (LEGADMINMAN)

1. Upon receipt of information which indicates an officer may have committed an act prescribed by a military or civilian criminal statute, and in accordance with the criteria set forth in chapter 4, paragraph 4002.1 of the reference, a report thereof will be made to the Commanding General, Training Command, at the soonest available opportunity.
2. Commanding Officers, Officers in Charge, or Senior Marine Representatives of organizations within Training Command are responsible for the timely and accurate submission of Officer Misconduct Reports.
3. Officer Misconduct Reports may be submitted via e-mail to the Adjutant Section, Training Command, and will contain all information required by chapter 4, paragraph 4002.3 of the reference.
