

This package contains information that I owe you identified in the Conference Message. We are about two weeks away from the conference, so the information within is as recent and accurate as possible. Please take time to review the following items prior to your departure.

1. **Dates:** The conference dates are 15 – 19 April, with travel on the 14th and 20th. Make sure your travel plans reflect this. Enclosure (1) is a copy of the official message.
2. **Agenda:** Enclosure (2) is the approved Agenda. This year's conference is packed with training and education. Major Core will brief the Visual Information Community's Vision, Mission and Goals. We will receive briefs on the Combat Development Process, Requirements, VI Systems, Logistics, and Training. Breakout sessions are scheduled for Officers, SNCO's and Civilian Managers. Expect to be given issues to discuss for courses of actions or recommendations, which will be presented to the conference on Friday. Finally, there are few guest speakers from within and outside of our community; a trip to the Defense VI Center and one social events.
3. **Location:** Enclosure (3) is a map to ensure you find our conference site with ease. The conference takes place at the Harbor Site Inn on Camp Del Mar, overlooking the Pacific Ocean and Oceanside Harbor & Marina. For those who are staying at the Inn, the conference center and bar are located on the 1st floor so you won't have to travel far for work or play. We have also acquired a Hospitality Suite on the 3rd floor for your convenience. Registration will take place in this room. Follow the signs in the lobby.
4. **Weather:** Whenever we travel, weather is the most important part of the trip. If you aren't prepared, you will not be able to focus on the task. Enclosure (4) is a weather forecast for this time of the year. I'd check the weather channel on TV or the web (www.weatherchannel.com) a day or two before you depart just to be safe.
5. **Registration Fee:** Please be prepared to pay the \$75.00 in cash on Sunday or Monday when you register. Master Sergeant Roberts is collecting the fees and making one payment to the TLF/Facilities manager from our account. Receipts will be given to you for travel reconciliation. The attendees from the local area can pay on Monday morning when you arrive for the first day of the conference. As noted above, this will take place in the Hospitality Suite on the 3rd floor.
6. **Billeting:** Enclosure (5) is group billeting information. Call and confirm the reservation on your credit card before you arrive. I will check on 12 April to see who has not confirmed. I will cancel all non-confirmed reservations that day. If you do not have billeting, call the Inn at 760-430-4714 for individual reservations. Our group is closed as of this date. If you have to stay off base, there are plenty of nice hotels and MSgt Roberts or I can give you recommendations if you call.

Be safe during your travels and be prepared to learn, have fun and build a stronger and better Visual Information Community that is prepared to support the Warfighter in the 21st Century.
